

PLEASE READ AND OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING

GUIDELINES THESE ARE FOR THE BENEFIT OF EVERYONE.

ADMINISTRATION: If you are first to arrive on site, (must have permission from the steward prior to arriving early or a fine may apply) confirm with the owner which field to use and act as steward until the appointed one arrives. Fixtures are subject to variation - please check 'Out & About', notices on site and the DA website. If in doubt about a meet, contact the steward before setting out. **FIRE PRECAUTIONS:** The minimum wall-to-wall or awning distance must be 20ft/6m. Please keep a full bucket of water outside your unit - this will ensure an immediate supply of water should a fire break out anywhere on site. **SAFETY:** The speed limit on site is 5 mph, this applies to all forms of transport, including cycles. Please be aware of children playing when driving on site. Parents are reminded that their children are their responsibility at all times.

HYGIENE: Toilets must only be emptied at a suitable disposal point and must not be cleaned at drinking water taps. Animals must be kept under control on leads not more than 2 meters long and exercised outside the camping area. Any fouling on site must be cleaned up as soon as possible.

RUBBISH: Rubbish must be taken home from all weekend meets. It must not be deposited in bins provided for licensed site campers.

COURTESY: Respect your steward's authority, he/she is in charge but is a volunteer and out to enjoy the weekend just like you.. Where possible, do not pitch your unit directly in front of another. Please consult the steward before operating a generator, you may be asked to pitch away from other units.

LICENCED SITES: NO on site facilities are to be used by rally attendees. i.e. shower/toilet block, rubbish bins. Observe all signs and speed limits.

CLUB'S COVID RULES: Your unit must not be closer than 6M to any adjacent unit.

You must observe the 2M rule with anyone not inside your 'bubble'. You 'can' meet in groups of up to 6. But you mustn't get closer than 2M to other groups of 6. When you're in small social groups then remember to keep your distance.

You must not use other people's caravans and awnings unless they are in your 'bubble'.

Wash your hands after doing.....anything.

Use some hand cleanser whenever you enter and leave shops, cafes and anywhere else where people come and go.

Keep the taps clean. Please follow good hygiene practises. Clean the tap after you use it with a wipe. Leave the packet of wipes by the tap and put your dirty wipes in a bin.

Only one person should be at the Elsan point at any time. Please be mindful of the special need for cleanliness in this area.

If you do not comply with these rules then you may be asked to leave the site.

If you have or develop any symptoms of Covid then.....please leave the site..... fast.....and get a test. But please also tell the Stewards via text or phone.
